
What are the common traits of Prophetic Church Leaders (Clergy or Lay)?

•Servant-oriented Leaders who actively promote Christ's Great Commission vision of salvation, deliverance and restoration through a transformative relationship (a new personal narrative) with Christ and his Church (i.e., the Church is a kingdom or theocracy).

•<u>Service-oriented Leaders</u> who use their gifts, distinct identities, and ministry positions to influence (through active *spiritual warfare*) their environment to achieve more moral (*good*), and less destructive (*evil*), Christian communities (e.g., the Church is NOT a business).

•**Spiritually-oriented Leaders** who are called to "speak divine truth to secular power", who control the dominate social narrative (*Royal Consciousness*)," giving voice to the needs, hopes and aspirations of those who are marginalized (e.g., the Church is NOT a social club).



- SEASON OF EDUCATION Where knowledge and information must be accumulated, but wisdom and experience needs to be developed. Talents are possibly recognized but not developed. Formal training of some type is necessary.
- SEASON OF VOCATION Where wisdom and application experience is accumulated, but fine judgement and compassion needs to be developed. Mentors, formal or informal, are necessary. Talents begin to mature and cluster into gifts.
- SEASON OF OCCUPATION Where the prior seasons have been completed enough for God to move us into our leadership destiny (family, church, community, career, etc.) according to the gifts he has given us!



What are the major steps on our Christian Journey?

Step #1: Become a *believer in Christ*, as God's Messiah...*WE ARE CALLED TO:*

- believe in Jesus-the Christ (John 3:16-21; 20:30-31)
- be saved by Jesus-the Christ (Romans 10:8-10)

Step #2: Become a *church member* and active follower of Christ...*WE ARE CALLED TO:*

- follow Jesus in unity (Ephesians 4:1-6)
- be God's co-workers (1 Corinthians 1:2; 3:9)

Step #3: Become a *church disciple* and servant of Christ...*WE ARE CALLED TO:*

- love one another and develop a prayer life (**John 15:1-14**)
- study God's word and keep it (John 8:31-32; 2 Timothy 2:15)
- **Step #4**: Become a *church evangelist* and trained soldier for Christ...*WE ARE CALLED TO:*
 - release God's deliverance power (Mark 16:15-18; John 14:12)
 - pull down Satan's strongholds (Ephesians 6:10-18)

Step #5: Become a *Christian witness* and ambassador for Christ to the world...*WE ARE CALLED TO:*

- share God's love and save souls (John 20:21-23; 2Corinthians 5:18-21)
- evangelize the world (i.e., to recruit new Christian soldiers, Acts 1:4-8)

| DESTINATION. God has a Heaven and Hell, and we must decide which one our soul will exist for all eternity. | Your Notes: |

| • God created Heaven to be the final destination for his family of believers-in and followers-of Jesus Christ. | |
| • God created Hell/Lake of Fire for Satan, his demons, and his human followers (READ: 2Peter 2:4; Rev. 20:1-15). | |
| DECISION. God wants to save everyone, but unfortunately everyone does not want to be saved! (READ: John 3:16-21) | |
| God has given every human being free will to choose – will we travel through this life with OR without Jesus (Luke 16:13)? | |
| • If we choose to travel with Jesus, like a divine GPS, he will lead us through life's trails and tribulations we all will face, and he will ensure we arrive in Heaven (READ: Psalm 23, John 14:1-7; Deut. 10:12-14; 2Corin. 5:7-9). | |

OUR PERSONAL JOURNEY WITH CHRIST STEP_2: "Become A Church Member" Study Outline

<u>RE-BORN TO LIVE</u>. The instant we Become a Christian Believer (Step 1), God releases the miracle of new spiritual life in us!

- The Holy Trinity gives spiritual birth inside of us to someone new inside of us (READ: John 1:1-4; John 3:1-8; 1Peter 1:22-25).
- We become "born-again," spiritually vs. physically, new creatures in Christ that never existed before (READ: John 1:10-12; 2Corin.5:12-17).
- True living is unlimited spiritual life with God (Zoe, the God-kind of life), vs. just limited physical existence separated from God (i.e, death).

RE-BORN TO GROW. God built Christ's Church because he knew that His re-Birthing process would produce spiritual babies who would need a new home filled with His love (see orange figures)!

- We need to be Church Members because we need the covering of Christ's Church for divine spiritual nurturing that only comes from feeding on God's word (READ: 1Corin.3:1-3; John15:1-7; Rom.12:1-2; Psalm 119:105).
- We need to be Church Members because we need the covering of Christ's Church for divine spiritual protection that only comes from living in God's house (READ: Matt.16:15-19; John 10:9-11; 1John 4:4).
- We need to be Church Members because we need the covering of Christ's Church for divine spiritual guidance that only come from the Lord of God's house (READ: Psalm 23:1-3; Prov.16:7-9; John 14:12-18).
- RE-BORN TO SERVE. God also built Christ's Church to grow an army of servant leaders strong and fit to fulfill Christ's Great Commission (READ: Eccl.12:13-14, see blue figures)!
 - We are called and expected to grow and become co-workers with Christ (READ: 1Corin.1:2, 3:9; 1Peter 2:9)
 - We are anointed and expected to grow and learn to follow Christ in God's Spirit of unity (READ: Ephesians 4:1-6)

John 1:1-4_1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He [Christ] was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4 In [Christ was and is] life, and the life was the light of men and women. 5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it..

John 3:1-8_1 There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. 2 This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." 3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." 4 Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" 5 Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' 8 The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

1Peter 1:22-25_22 Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, **23** having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides [m]forever, **24** because "All flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, and its flower falls away, **25** But the word of the Lord endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.

1Peter 2:9-10_9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; **10** who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

ANATOMY OF CHURCH DISCIPLES. Being a Member is NOT the same as being a Disciple. Time in Christ's Church is NOT the same as building his Church. Older Disciples need to mentor younger Disciples. On *Our Personal Journey with Christ*, our most difficult and lengthy personal transformation is from Church Member (which is about our own needs as babes) to Church Disciple (which is about our service to do the Lord's will).

<u>TRANSFORMED HEART</u>. God expects His new born Members to actively engaged in Church ministries to cultivate compassionate hearts!

- *Mature Church Disciples* have cultivated pure and sensitive hearts, through a daily prayer life, that can hear Christ's voice (Psalm 51:6-8; John 10:14-16).
- *Mature Church Disciples* have cultivated caring hearts, through ministry to the sick and shut-in, poor and needy, and lost souls (Prov.31:8-9; Matt.25:31-46)
- *Mature Church Disciples* have cultivated strong hearts, through community and social justice ministry (Micah 6:6-8).

TRANSFORMED MIND. God expects His new born Members to actively engaged in Church ministries to cultivate disciplined minds!

- *Mature Church Disciples* have cultivated new minds, through daily Bible Study, to think like Christ (Rom.12:1-2; Phil.2:5-8; 2Tim.2:14-16).
- *Mature Church Disciples* have cultivated new attitudes, through daily keeping His commandments, to do right in His sight (John 14:12-18).
- *Mature Church Disciples* have cultivated new work ethic, through daily focus on ways to build and advance Christ's Church (James 1:21-26; Prov.16:7-9).

TRANSFORMED SOUL. God expects His new born Members to be actively engaged in Church ministries to cultivate accountable souls!

- Mature Church Disciples ask: What can I do for the Church (i.e., ministry roles and responsibilities can I do); NOT what can the Church do for me (1Corin.1:2).
- *Mature Church Disciples* hold themselves accountable, from the Pulpit to the Pews, for the Church's spiritual health and longevity, as well as the positive atmosphere and welfare in our homes, communities, and jobs (1John 4:4).
- BOTTOM-LINE. God wants more Church Members accept the challenge of working each day to become Church Disciples—with the help of the Lord!

2Peter 2:14-16_14 Remind [Church Members] of these things, and charge them before NOTES: the Lord not to strive about words to no profit, to the ruin of the hearers. 15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, as workers who do not need to be ashamed, rightly ______ dividing the word of truth. 16 But shun profane and idle babblings, for they will increase to more ungodliness.

James 1:21-26_21 Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. 22 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. 23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; 24 for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. 25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does. 26 If anyone among you thinks they are religious (i.e., a Church Disciple), and does not bridle their tongue but deceives their own heart, this one's religion is useless. 27 Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world.

Our Personal Journey with Christ STEP 4: "Become A Church Evangelist" Study Outline

CHURCH EVANGELIST. As we complete our basic training and mature to become Church Disciples, Christ then commissions us to do "standard" ministry roles that he expects to be done in each of His Churches, i.e., we are commissioned to do ministry, to save lost souls, and to evangelize our world.

Commissioned to Minister. *The word "ministry" means to serve.*

- · God expects Church Members, by serving in Church ministries, to become mature and skilled Church Disciples, fit for the Master's use. (Heb.5:12-14)
- · For mature Church Disciples this means to serve others as Christ served and saved humanity! (Matt.20:25-28)
- saved, delivered, and blessed us, we should welcome and embrace our role to serve as coworkers with Christ--through thick and thin! (2Corin.6:1-10; 2Tim.2:1-4)
- Commissioned to Save Souls. The word "save" means to avoid a terrible loss, especially when something could have been done.
 - For Church Evangelist this means to lead others to saving faith in Christ! terrible thing to loose! (Rom.10:11-17)
 - · So we must work on becoming Church Evangelist and whatever else God wants us to be in order to win as many souls as we can for Christ in our lifetime! (1Corin. 9:22-23)
- Commissioned to Evangelize. The word "evangelize" means to gossip with great enthusiasm.
 - · For Church Evangelist this means equipping the saints for the work of Christ's ministry in our communities and nations. (Eph.4:11-15)
 - For Church Evangelist this also means to passionately share the gospel which is the good news of Christ—with all who will listen! (2Tim.4:1-5)
 - BOTTOM-LINE. As trained and anointed soldiers in the divine army of the Lord, God calls Church Evangelist to spread the gospel of Christ and release His power, like wildfire, throughout our community, our nations, and our world! (Mark 16:15-18)!

Hebrews 5:12-14 _14 For by this time you ought to be teachers, you [shouldn't] need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles [and principles of God's righteousness]; and you [shouldn't] need milk and [you should be able to consume] solid food. 13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, [for they are still babies in the Church]. 14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use [and consistent work in the Church] have their senses exercised [and are mature and skilled enough] to discern both good and evil.

CHRISTIAN WITNESSES. As we mature into Church Disciples and Romans 10:11-17_11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him Evangelist ("Special Forces" of the Kingdom of God) on Our Personal blessings and miracles in our personal lives-for God is faithful!

- □ SENT TO RECONCILE. God sends Disciples who are prepared into the world as his Special Forces to compel to accept Christ as their Lord and Savior.
 - As Special Forces Disciples of Christ, God anoints our personal testimony on OPJwC so that we can use it as a tool to help others find his Light and his Way to salvation! (ROMANS 10:11-17)
- SENT TO DELIVER. God sends Disciples who are prepared into the 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God... world as Ambassadors of Christ to help others to find his divine miracles and deliverance in a world full of problems, issues and concerns or P.I.C.'s.
 - · As Ambassadors of Christ, God expects us to share our personal testimony with others who are lost and struggling to make it on the dark sea of life--just as God saved and reconciled each of us when we lost and without hope in this world. (2CORINTHIANS 5:18-21)
 - · As Ambassadors of Christ, God anoints us to share the gospel of salvation, to baptized and make new disciples, to heal the sick and cast out demons, to encourage the broken-hearted--and he told them do this all in the power of Christ's name! (JOHN 14:11-14)
- □ SENT TO WITNESS. God sends Disciples who are prepared into the eternal life across each new generation.
 - · As Christian Witnesses, God empowers us to share his divine love and forgiveness with our family, and with our friends. (ACTS 1:1-8)
 - · As Christian Witnesses, God expects us to also share his free gift of eternal life with strangers, and with anyone in our world who will listen. (JOHN 3:16-21)

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Rev. Dr. W. Golden Carmon, Sr. (Biographical Summary)

A North Carolina native, **Rev. Dr. W. Golden Carmon, Sr.** became the Senior Pastor of Mt. Zion AMEC of New Brunswick-NJ in June 2018. He formerly served as the Pastor of Mt. Zion AMEC of Plainfield-NJ for 13-years. He was the Chairman of their Economic Development Corporation, established in 2006. In April 2010, He led that church to acquire a 12,000-sqft edifice and school, situated on a 1.5-acre campus. He serves as the Vice Chairman of the AMEC NJ Annual Conference Board of Trustees. He has served as a NJAC Ministerial Institute instructor of Church Admin., Stewardship and Finance.

Ministry Leadership. From 2001 to 2005, Rev. Dr. Carmon served as Pastor of St. Marks AMEC of Cranford-NJ. There he was a member of the Clergy Council, and under his leadership the church grew and was spiritually revived. Together they paid-off the mortgage, completed facility upgrades, and established a TV ministry. From 1983 to 2000, he served at North Stelton AMEC of Piscataway-NJ in a variety of ministries. These included the Steward Board, Church School Teacher, Prayer and Worship Team, Class Leader, Stewardship and Finance Ministry, Men's Ministry, and the Media Ministry. He served as the Chief of Ministry Staff, and led the hospital and nursing home; sick and shut-in; and, new members' ministries. He was co-founder of the Food Pantry Ministry.

Business Career. In 2014, Rev. Dr. Carmon retired as an IBM Executive where his business career spanned 33-years. His final assignment was leading a global team responsible for the \$4.4 billion annual strategic relationships with IBM's largest global business partners. He also served as Recruiting Executive for Tennessee State University. For 4-years prior to joining IBM, he was a Member of the Technical Staff (MTS) and Telecom Engineer for AT&T Bell Labs.

Ordination and Education. Rev. Carmon was ordained an AMEC Itinerant Deacon and Elder in 1993 and 1998 respectively. He holds a Doctor of Ministry (DMin) from historic Drew University (concentration in Church Growth and Spiritual Formation). He holds a Masters of Divinity (MDiv) from New Brunswick Theological Seminary (NBTS). He also holds a Masters and a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering from Cornell University. He completed 3-years of advanced business certifications, required for IBM Executives, at Harvard and Boston University Business Schools.

Family Life. Rev. Dr. W. Golden Carmon, Sr. is married to Rev. Dr. Mattie A. Carmon who serves as Mt. Zion's Assistant Pastor. She holds a DMin from Drew University, an MDiv from NBTS, and a Bachelor of Science from Limestone College. Inclusive by marriage (i.e., son and daughter-in-law's) they have 4-daughters, 3-sons, 9-grandchildren, and 3-great-grandchildren. His motto is: "*Building God's House One Life at a Time*" (Psalm 127:1).
